Long Beach Public Health Laboratory is a certified laboratory that tests dust wipes, paint, soil, water, consumer products, and miscellaneous items for lead. There is a low cost fee for testing these items. **You must contact the lab for the correct way to collect samples.** For more information, please call **562.570.4080** Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, to speak with someone from the lab.

Type of Samples You May Collect

Dust Wipes

Dust wipes are used to collect dust in a specific area that may have lead. Collect samples from window sills, floors, or other areas that may have lead dust.

Paint Chips

You may send samples of peeling paint to be analyzed. You may place the paint chips in the zip lock bag when submitting your sample.

Soil

Soil samples may be submitted to be analyzed. You may place the soil sample in the zip lock bag when submitting your sample.

Water

You may submit water sample to be tested. Please call the Long Beach Public Health Lab on how to mail your water samples.
