<b>ATP</b>	ABILITY-TO-PAY PLAN at County hospitals and clinics at no cost or at lower cost. <b>Access for Infants &amp; Mothers (AIM)</b>	It is a low-cost health coverage for pregnant women and their newborn.	Designed for middle-income families with no health insurance and whose income is too high to qualify for no-cost Medi-Cal and who are not in other programs.	Limited income guidelines, pregnant, but not more than 30 weeks, as of the application date.	A California resident who has lived in California for the last 6 months.	Covers medically necessary services from your effective date of coverage in the AIM Program until 60 days after your pregnancy has ended.
