(NEW) Health Education using ABCDE's to Envisioning a Healthy Future focusing on preconception health before & after pregnancy (adapted from County of Los Angeles Department of Public Health)

- · ABUSE Alcohol, Cigarettes, Illicit Drugs, Domestic Violence
- BEHAVIORAL-Mental Illness
- CHRONIC DISEASE-Overweight/Obesity, HT, Diabetes, Epilepsy, Asthma
- DIET, DRUGS & DAD's- Nutrition & Exercise, Pharmaceuticals and male involvement
- ENVIRONMENTAL EXPOSURES- Occupational, Household, food
- STI's (sexually transmitted infections), SHOTS (Immunizations), SCREENING(Genetic)
