



Percent of Total Live Births by Service Planning Area (SPA) Los Angeles County, 2007





Percent of Total Live Births by Mother's Trimester Prenatal Care (PNC) Began Los Angeles County, 2007




Percent of Total Live Births by Adequacy of Prenatal Care Utilization Index Los Angeles County, 2007





Percent of Total Live Births by Parity and by Mother's Race/Ethnicity Los Angeles County, 2007





Percent of Total Live Births by Mother's Trimester Prenatal Care (PNC) Began and by Mother's Race/Ethnicity Los Angeles County, 2007



Percent of Total Live Births by Gestational Age and by Service Planning Area (SPA) Los Angeles County, 2007







