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



Percent of Total Live Births by Service Planning Area (SPA) Los Angeles County, 2010











Percent of Total Live Births by Source of Payment for Prenatal Care (PNC) and by Mother's Race/Ethnicity Los Angeles County, 2010







Los Angeles County - Department of Public Health Number of Live Births by Zip Code* and Service Planning Area (SPA) Los Angeles County, 2010




