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



Percent of Total Live Births by Service Planning Area (SPA) Los Angeles County, 2012











Percent of Total Live Births by Birthweight and by Mother's Race/Ethnicity Los Angeles County, 2012









Percent of Total Live Births by Mother's Years of Education and by Mother's Race/Ethnicity Los Angeles County, 2012





Percent of Total Live Births by Birthweight and by Service Planning Area (SPA) Los Angeles County, 2012





Percent of Total Live Births by Gestational Age and by Service Planning Area (SPA) Los Angeles County, 2012













Los Angeles County - Department of Public Health Number of Live Births by Zip Code* and Service Planning Area (SPA) Los Angeles County, 2012
