

Teen Fertility Rate

INDICATOR: Fertility Rate Among Girls

DEFINITION: The number of live births per 1,000 adolescent females by age at delivery

(less than 15 years of age, 15 to 17 years of age, 18 to 19 years of age)

NUMERATOR: The total number of live births among adolescent females, by age group (less than 15, 15 to 17, 18 to 19), by place of residence, in a calendar year

DENOMINATOR: The total number of adolescent females by age group (less than 15, 15 to 17, 18 to 19), by place of residence, in a calendar year

HEALTHY PEOPLE 2010 OBJECTIVE:

Reduce pregnancies among adolescent females to no more than 43 pregnancies per 1,000 adolescents.

(Baseline: 68 pregnancies per 1,000 females aged 15 to 17 years in 1996) (Objective 9-7)

HEALTHY PEOPLE 2020 OBJECTIVE:

Reduce pregnancies among adolescent females to no more than 36 pregnancies per 1,000 adolescents. (Baseline: 40.2 pregnancies per 1,000 females aged 15 to 17 years in 2005) (Objective FP-8.1)

RISK FACTORS:

Low income; low maternal education level; race/ethnicity (African American, Hispanic); lack of effective contraceptive use/family planning practices; lack of education/counseling regarding contraceptive use/family planning; previous teen pregnancy; initiation of sexual activity at a young age










Year 2010 Objectives: Increase the proportion of pregnant women who receive early and adequate prenatal care to 90 percent of live births.

Year 2020 Objectives: Increase the proportion of pregnant women who receive early and adequate prenatal care to 77.9 percent of live births.


Note: The APNCU Index measures prenatal care utilization, which includes consideration of the month prenatal care began and the number of prenatal care visits during the time mothers actually received prenatal care. This utilization index is based on the recommendations established by the American College of Obstetrics and Gynecologists (ACOG). Appendix A contains the specific criteria for timing and number of prenatal care visits that are used to assign adequacy categories.


