



Find a COVID-19 Vaccine Site Near You!

The COVID-19 vaccine is available to everyone 6 months of age and older

- The vaccine is free.
- You will not be asked about your immigration status when you get a vaccine.
- You do not need to have health insurance to get a vaccine.
- Vaccines are available at hundreds of locations across LA County including clinics, pharmacies, pediatrician's offices, schools, places of worship, parks, metro stations, and more.
- No appointment is needed at many locations.

3 Easy Ways to Get Vaccinated in LA County:

(1) Visit ph.lacounty.gov/howtogetvaccinated and use the search feature to find the right site for you.

o If you are taking a child to get a vaccine, call ahead to make sure the site has the right vaccine your child and ask about parent or caregiver consent.

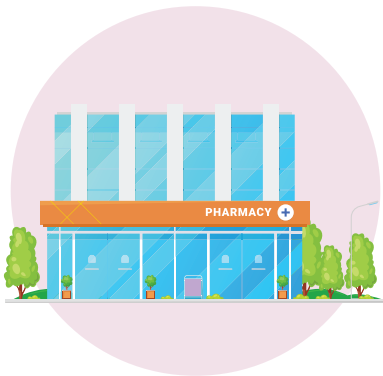
o Note, most pharmacies cannot vaccinate children under 3.



(2) Call the Vaccine Call Center at **(833) 540-0472**. The Call Center is open daily from 8:00am to 8:30pm.

o The Call Center can also arrange in-home vaccination and free transportation.

(3) Call 2-1-1, which is open 24/7 and has information in many languages.



All vaccines available in LA County are safe and effective at preventing serious illness and death from COVID-19.

- People 12 and older can get the Pfizer, Moderna, or Novavax vaccine.
- People under 12 can get the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine
