# LOS ANGELES COUNTY TRAUMA PREVENTION INITIATIVE

## Community Empowerment & Systems Change

### Intervention

#### Hospital Based Violence Intervention (HBVI)

24/7 response to victims of violence in trauma hospitals and case management post release including gang intervention, victim services, employment, mentoring and social services.

#### Street Outreach & Community

Conflict mediation, peace maintenance, prevention of retaliatory violence, safe passages at parks and schools, and linkage to needed health, mental health, and social services.

### Capacity Building

#### Peer-to-Peer Violence Prevention Learning Academy

Trauma informed cross-training opportunities for promotoras, community health workers, and community intervention workers.

#### Training & Technical Assistance Team

Monthly capacity-building workshops and one-on-one consultations with CBOs in TPI communities working on violence prevention and/or intervention.
