There have been shootings in nearby communities that have caused staff meetings to be organized.</p> <p><b>LASD Century Station</b> – Deputy Gonzalez shared the statistics of crime in the Willowbrook area for July. As of July 25<sup>th</sup>, there were 0 homicides 0 shootings, 1 rape, 4 assaults, 1 robbery, 9 thefts, 10 auto thefts, and 2 arsons.
