Community Safety Updates	Southern California Crossroads – 2 black males were shot on Slater, 1 Hispanic male was shot on Rosecrans Ave, 1 Hispanic male was shot near Avalon, 15-year-old was fatally shot near 135 th St, 1 Hispanic male was shot near 120 St, and 1 Hispanic male was found dead in RV. There have been multiple ongoing incidents in the area due to a male experiencing a mental health crisis. Currently, Crossroads is attempting to find local and non-law enforcement resources for the man. LASD Century Station – Deputy Gonzalez shared the statistics of crime in the Willowbrook area for August. As of 8/22, there were θ homicides, θ rape, 1 assault, 5 robberies, 12 thefts, 1 auto theft, and 1 arson. No stats were able to be given solely on street racing incidents. Kenneth Carson would like to learn more about protocol regarding incidents. The steering committee chairs will be meeting with Captain Torres soon.
