By June 30, 2022 the RVPC in SPA 5 will meet with school administrators at every public high school in the SPA, resulting in a "Schools are Safe Zones" campaign on at least 5 school campuses. This goal was selected because our landscape analysis highlighted concerns from parents and teachers about the amount of violence occurring in and near high schools in our SPA. Our coalition identified youth interpersonal violence as a top priority, which aligns with this goal.
