

COVID-19 Requirements: Schools

- Reopening Protocols for K-12 Schools: emphasizing vaccination as first line of prevention and urging policies that normalize, promote, and facilitate vaccination for all eligible persons.
- Indoor masking requirement for anyone entering school buildings or transports – narrow exceptions if medical reasons for why someone cannot use or tolerate a face mask.
- Unmasked staff are required, and unmasked students are recommended, to be tested for COVID-19 at least twice weekly.
- Symptom Screening: Individuals should not come to school if they are sick or under isolation or quarantine orders.
- Physical distancing strategies are still recommended as long as they do not interfere with full-time attendance for all students



CDC Health Advisory: Increases in Availability of Cannabis Products Containing Delta-8 THC and Reported Cases of Adverse Events

- Increased availability of cannabis products containing delta-8 tetrahydrocannabinol (Δ8-THC) lead to adverse events consistent with cannabis intoxication
- Symptoms of $\Delta 8$ -THC intoxication:
- Lethargy
- Uncoordinated movements and decreased psychomotor activity
- Slurred speech
- Increased heart rate progressing to slowed heart rate

- Low blood pressure
- Difficulty breathing
- Sedation
- Coma
