

TB Clearance for K-12 Students

Take the Report of Health Exam for School Entry Form to your pediatrician or, if you don't insurance, you can take your form to a Child Health and Disability Prevention Provider.

*The TB risk assessment can be completed up to a year prior to 90 days after entry to a new school district.



The provider will do a TB Risk Assessment and order a TB skin or blood test and/or chest x-ray, if needed, along with the required physical exam for school entry.



Your provider will complete the Report of Health Examination for School Entry Form after confirming you do not have infectious TB, or if needed will direct you to appropriate treatment.



Give the completed Report of Health Examination for School Entry Form which is attached to the TB Risk Assessment to your school nurse or other designated school official.

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
