TB Clearance Process for Parent and School Volunteers

Answer the Adult <u>TB Risk Assessment questions</u> with a licensed medical provider of your own or at your school. If you do not have a healthcare provider or insurance, go to the nearest <u>Public Health- Nurse Walk In Clinic</u>

If "no TB risk identified" – from the TB Risk Assessment questions, your school designee will fill out a <u>TB Clearance Form</u>

Finished

If you answered "yes" on any of the questions on the TB Risk Assessment – you will need a TB skin or blood test (IGRA)

If your TB skin or blood test is negative – your doctor can complete the TB Clearance Form

Finished

If your TB skin or blood test is positive you will need a chest x-ray. The doctor will complete the medical evaluation, may direct you for treatment or further testing if needed.

Once cleared of having contagious TB disease the provider can complete the TB Clearance form.

Take the completed <u>TB Clearance Form</u> to your <u>school nurse or other designated school official</u>

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
